1. I have spent several years serving on the Eastern Cape Region's Interest Group Committee during which time I have seen and helped to facilitate growth in attendance numbers from 4 or 5 members to an average of 20 to 30 members per quarterly meeting. I intend to maintain and if possible expand this attendance by inviting more potential members and by ensuring that topics, discussions, presentations and training offered at the meetings is relevant, interesting, interactive and technically correct.
2. I was a Board member of the ACFESA between 2017 and 2018 and also served on the Risk Sub-Committee of the National Board. I will continue to utilise the support group of sponsors, firms and similar benefactors built up over many years and involving a number of different firms, institutions and individuals, to ensure that appropriate venues are arranged, and that attending members and prospective members are catered for.
