

CERTIFIED FRAUD EXAMINER OF THE YEAR

The Certified Fraud Examiner of the Year Award is presented to a CFE who has demonstrated outstanding achievement in the field of fraud examination.

CRITERIA:

- 1. The Nominee *must have been instrumental in introducing innovative anti-fraud tools, controls, techniques, or methodologies in his/her organisation*. There should be a willingness to have an article published on the subject. A brief paper on the subject should accompany the nomination.
- The Nominee must have contributed to the ACFE SA through active participation at Board or Regional level, by having articles published on topical subjects in local or overseas anti-fraud related periodicals, or making presentations on topical subjects at local or international level etc.
- 3. The nominee played a significant role in an investigation(s) of significant fraud(s).
- 4. The nominee played a significant role in the design and installation(s) of anti-fraud controls.
- 5. The nominee made a significant contribution to the field of anti-fraud training or education.
- 6. The nominee contributed significantly to the discipline of fraud examination.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. CFEs registered with the local South African Chapter are eligible to receive this award.
- 2. This person must be a CFE in good standing.
- 3. The nominee must display strong ethical and professional values.
