

EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Educator of the Year Award is presented to an ACFE Educator member who has made an outstanding contribution to anti-fraud education. Factors that will be considered in selecting the recipient are:

CRITERIA:

- 1. The nominee/nominee organisation must have made a noteworthy contribution which significantly enhanced the educational standing of the forensic investigation/auditing profession in South Africa.
- 2. The individual must have contributed to the ACFE SA.
- 3. The individual might have been involved in Anti-fraud curriculum development efforts creating a career path for the profession at their university or college.
- 4. The individual might have involved other departments/faculties within the academic profession promoting the profession in doing so.
- 5. This individual might have been solely or jointly responsible for the number of CFE's that successfully came into the profession.
- 6. As an organisation, the entity provided a unique opportunity for training of members and/or the broader public.
- 7. The nominee should also be active in their community.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. For individual nominees, preference will be given to nominees who have attained or are studying towards the CFE status.
